Petitions must be submitted to ACM Headquarters for verification by March 29, 2013.

Provided there are no petition candidates, ACM will begin sending out email notifications/postcards in April 2013 when the election web site goes live. Please make sure your SIGAda membership is active by or before March 13, 2013 to ensure that you will be eligible to vote in this election. All

ballots are due on or before June 14, 2013 when the online voting site closes. All candidates will be notified of the election results by July 1, 2013.
